You have access to the IDE Computer Lab from 8am to 5pm everyday for computer usage and internet access.

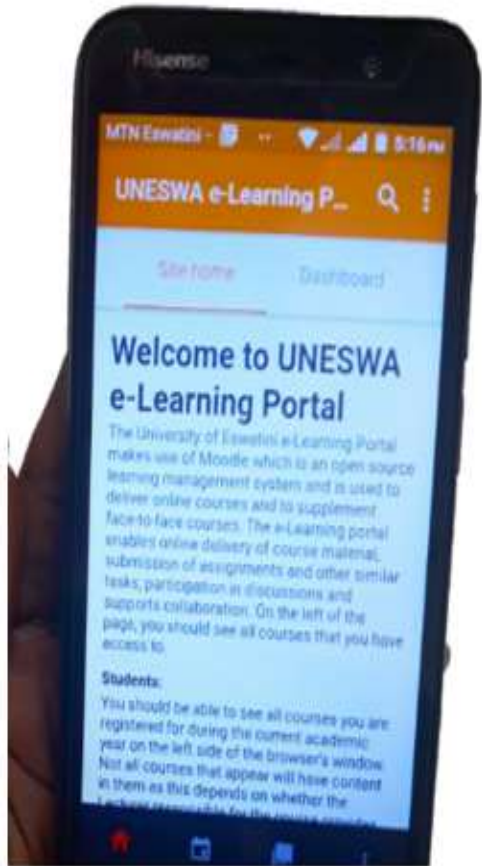
